New Compliance Guidance

OIG Modernization of Compliance Program Guidance Documents (4/25/23)

- OIG will no longer publish updated or new CPGs in the Federal Register. All current, updated, and new CPGs will be available on their website
- OIG will publish a General CPG (GCPG) that applies to all individuals and entities involved in the health care industry.
- Second, OIG will publish industry-specific CPGs (ICPGs) for different types of providers, suppliers, and other participants in health care industry subsectors or ancillary industry sectors relating to Federal health care programs.



OIG Modernization of Compliance Program Guidance Documents (4/25/23)

 The 2023 announcement explained that OIG anticipates that the first two industry segment-specific CPGs (ICPGs) will address Medicare Advantage and nursing facilities. OIG intends to publish these guidance documents in 2024. For the next two ICPGs, OIG anticipates addressing hospitals and clinical laboratories.
