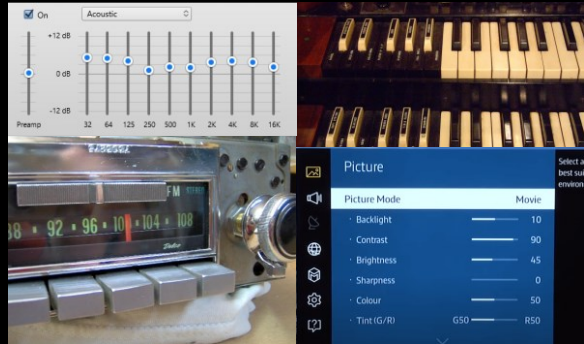

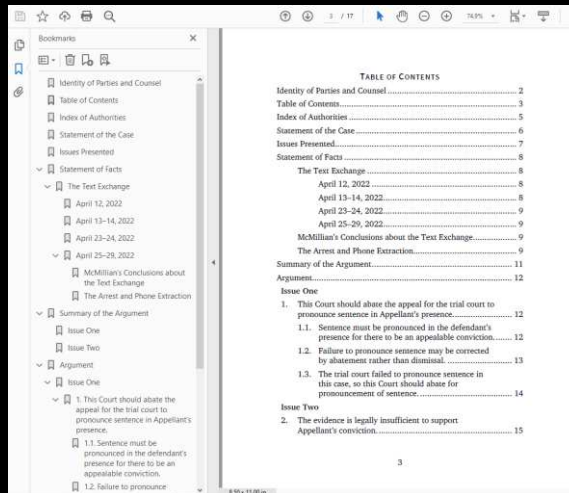
Built-in styles are combinations of formatting characteristics that you can apply to text to quickly change its appearance.
