Recent Policy Initiatives on Intellectual Property in <u>Federal</u> Government Contracts

- Overview of Confidentiality Issues
 - Trade Secrets Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1905; See CACI, Inc. v. United States, 674 F.Supp.3d 57 (E.D. Va. 2023) (entering injunction in favor of CACI to prevent further disclosure of CACI's trade secret information and ordering forensic computer analysis).
 - Use of Non-Disclosure Agreements; See Demodulation, Inc. v. United States, 103 Fed. Cl. 794, 798 (2012); Liberty Ammunition, Inc. v. United States, 835 F.3d 1388, 1401 (Fed. Cir. 2016).
 - FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552
 - "Reverse" FOIA See CNA Fin. Corp. v. Donovan, 830 F.2d 1132, 1133 n.1 (D.C. Cir. 1987).
 - FAR/DFARS See, e.g., FAR 52.215-1, Instructions to Offerors (marking proposals)
