Hardware, software, integrated technologies or related licenses, intellectual property, upgrades, or packaged solutions sold as services that are designed for or support use by health care entities or patients for electronic creation, maintenance, access, or exchange of health information.

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Health IT vs. Consumer Health Apps



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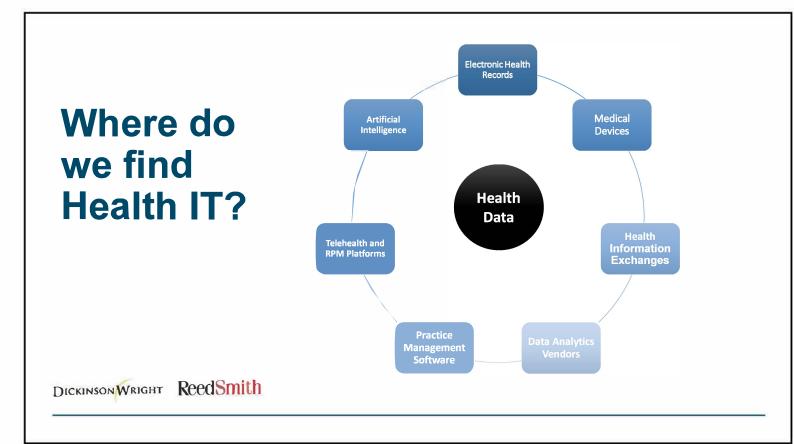


Consumer Health Apps
