2024 Rules Vote:

Question: Who Initiated the Proposed Rules we Voted on in April 2024?

Answer: The CDRR Proposed and Initiated the Rules included in 2024. And, to accomplish that, the CDRR:

- Reviewed rules in other jurisdictions
- Found and addressed Issues of ambiguity requiring clarification
- Modernized Terminology
- Conflicts Rules and developed and explained "Screening"
- Addressed Terminating "Custodianship"

How Did the Vote Come Out?

The 12 propositions passed as follows:

A −1.00 Terminology	85.11 %
B —1.08 Conflicts with Client	80.94 %
C -1.09 Conflict-former Client	80.86 %
D -1.10 Imputation Conflicts	80.36 %
E —1.18 Prospective Client	78.21 %
F —3.09 Special Duties of Prosecutor	85.93 %

How Did the Vote Come Out? (Cont'd)



The 12 propositions passed as follows:

G —4.03 Dealing with Unrep Person 77.48 %

H —5.01 Resp. of Supervisory Lawyer 75.66 %

I —5.05 Unauthorized Law Practice 82.63 %

J —8.05 Jurisdiction 81.52 %

K —8.06 Choice of Law 82.55 %

L — RDP 13.05 Termination Custodianship 85.89 %
