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

- Eligibility
 - Non-financial
 - Financial
- Transfer rules

Medicaid Eligibility: Non-Financial Criteria

- Citizenship
- Residence
- Age, Blindness, Disability
- Medical necessity
- Medicaid facility, Medicaid bed

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Medicaid: Transfers for Less Than Fair Market Value

- Cannot give assets away within five years of filing application and qualify
- Penalty period assessed
 - Amount of gift / current divisor (\$242.13 in 2024)
- Penalty period begins when person enters nursing home, applies for Medicaid, and would be eligible but for transfer

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
