

Key Texas State Law Definitions of SIJ Determinations

Abuse under TFC §261.001(1)(A)-(M)

Mental or Emotional Injury resulting in "an observable and impairment of the child's growth, development, or psychological functioning';


Engaging in or failing to make a reasonable effort to prevent "physical injury that results in substantial harm to a child's mental, emotional, or a physical welfare";

Abuse Examples

Engaging	Engaging in or failing to make reasonable effort to prevent sexual conduct
Using	Using controlled substances and the use results in physical, mental or emotional injury of the child
Forcing or coercing	Forcing or coercing a child to enter into marriage
