
A PATHOLOGICAL CLAUSE


All disputes under this agreement the parties agree to arbitrate in accordance with the arbitration rules of the New York Chamber of Commerce by one or more arbitrators.


Both parties irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Taiwan.
