Charging Order History
 Origins in general partnership law Designed to protect interests of other partners Joint and several liability for partnership obligations Partner's power to bind partnership Replaced earlier law allowing creditors of partner to reach partnership property Inherent application to multi-owner entities TBOC 152.308
 Carried over to limited partnership law TBOC 153.256 By definition of partner, applies to general partners and limited partners
 Carried over to limited liability company law TBOC 101.112
 Focus on limited liability company law but applies to partnerships as well
