### **EEOC:** what laws do we enforce?

- Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VII).
- Equal Pay Act of 1963 (EPA).
- Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967 (ADEA).
- Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
- Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA).
- ADA Amendments Act of 2008 (ADAAA).
- Genetic Information Non-Discrimination Act of 2008 (GINA).

### The laws apply to the EEO world of work

- EEO = Equal Employment Opportunity
  - Recruiting, interviewing, and job testing.
  - Reasonable accommodation and leave.
  - Work assignments, promotions, demotions, and transfers.
  - Performance evaluations.
  - Write-ups and disciplinary actions.
  - Pay, benefits, and other compensation.
  - Firing and layoffs.
