

Understanding Social Security



Social Security has two Major Disability Programs

Social Security Disability Insurance (Title II)

Payments come from the Social Security trust funds and are based on income

A merit-based insurance program for workers who paid Social Security taxes on wages (Supplement Security Income Title 16)

Payments come from the general treasury fund, NOT the Social Security trust funds.
