- ▶ These standards are to provide guidance to appellate practitioners, but only violations of the Disciplinary Rules are subject to sanction by the State Bar.

- ▶ 120 Suspensions
- ▶ 27 Resignations in Lieu of Discipline
- ▶ 99 Grievance Referral Program
