Subrogation vs Reimbursement vs Assignment

Case law: “no meaningful difference between [subro or reimb].” *Wausau v Wedel* TxSCt 06 08 2018. BUT:

BAM! Blue, Aldous and Malouf & \$114M jm for Hill.
Aldous v Darwin Nat’l Assurance Co 5th Cir, 03/16/17:

“Darwin, get off your Nat’l Ass and sue the third party, because your subro interest vs 3rd party is not a right of reimb against your own insured.”



Ch. 140 Civil Prac. & Rem. Code, as of 01/01/2014

For insured health, disability, occ injury; & self-funded gov’t plans (they all share in 1/3 if >1)

Does Not regulate w/c, M/Care or M/Caid

1/3 1/3 1/3 of 3rd party recovery (if atty)

No subrogation to PIP

No subrogation to UM/UIM if ptf or family bought it

No subro to children’s or w/d recoveries

Be consistent, be strategic.

PJC 15.5 Personal Injury Damages—Injury of Minor Child

QUESTION _____

PJC 15.5 includes elements of damages (e.g., loss of earning capacity and medical care expenses incurred before the age of majority) that reflect injuries to the minor, but that are not recoverable by the minor, the Committee felt that a revision was necessary
