Title IX: Retaliation Claims

Elements

- Plaintiff engaged in activity protected by Title IX
- Defendant knew of the protected activity
- Defendant subsequently took adverse action
- A retaliatory motive caused the adverse action

Title IX: Retaliation Claims

IF v. Lewisville ISD

- High school student alleged sexual assault by other students at off-campus party
- Claimed that LISD failed to respond adequately to IF's reports of off-campus assault and of bullying/harassment at school
- Claimed that LISD was deliberately indifferent to IF's reports
