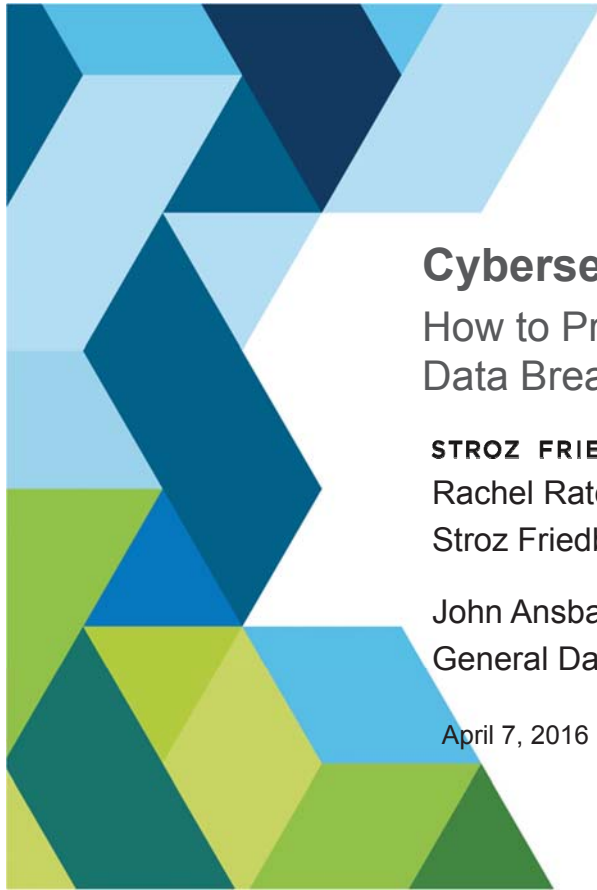

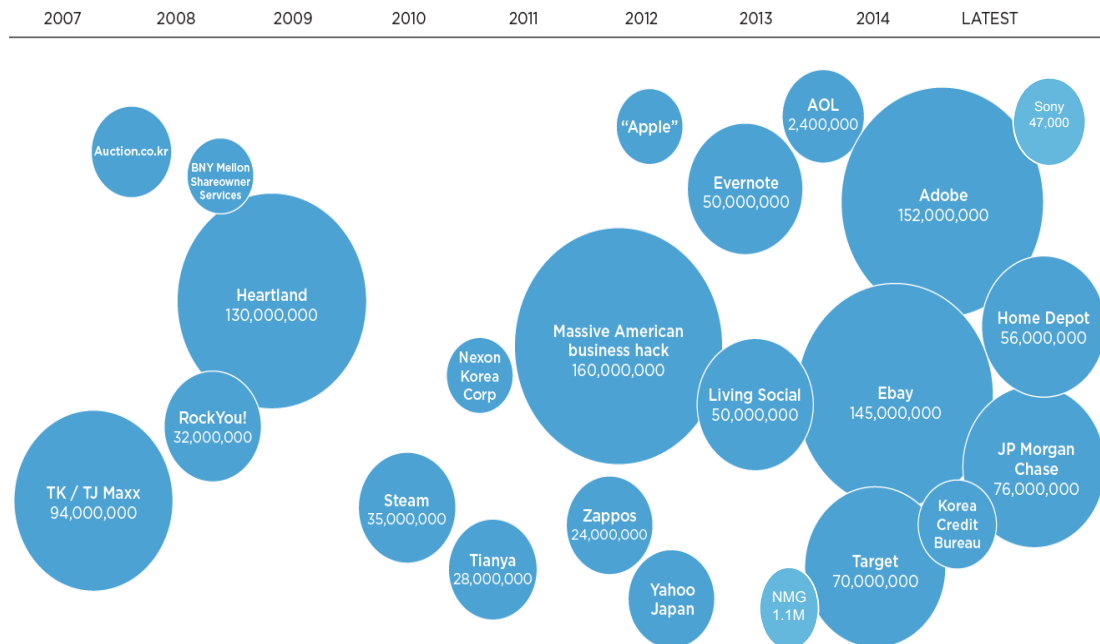

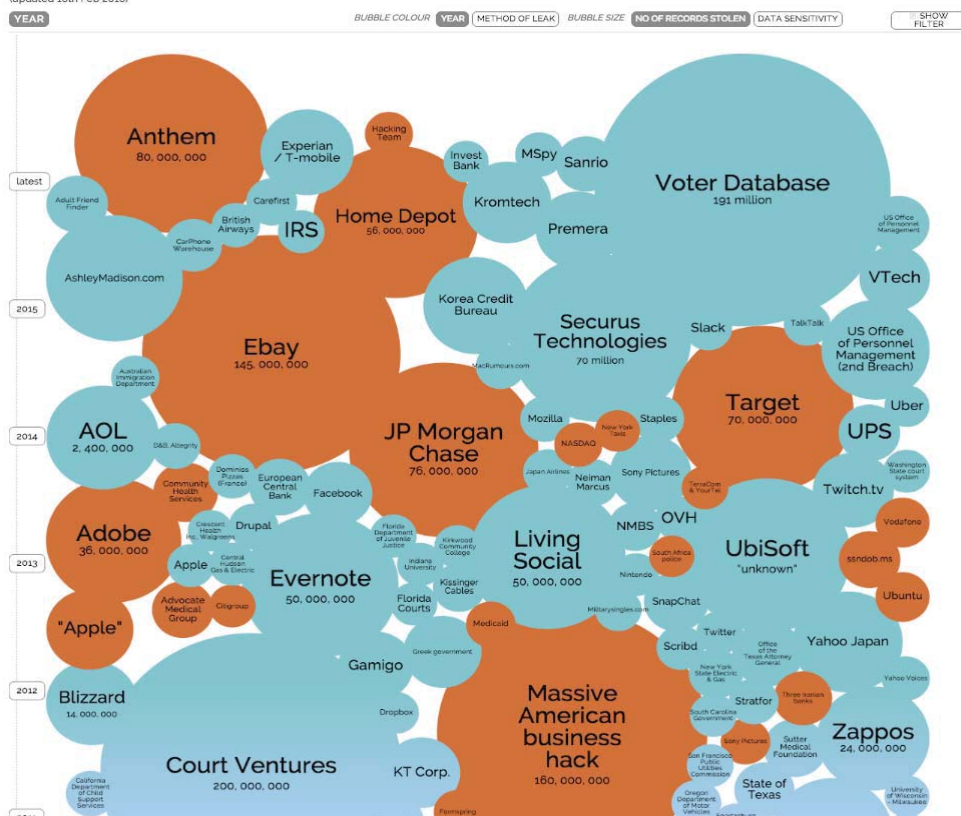
Before 2014

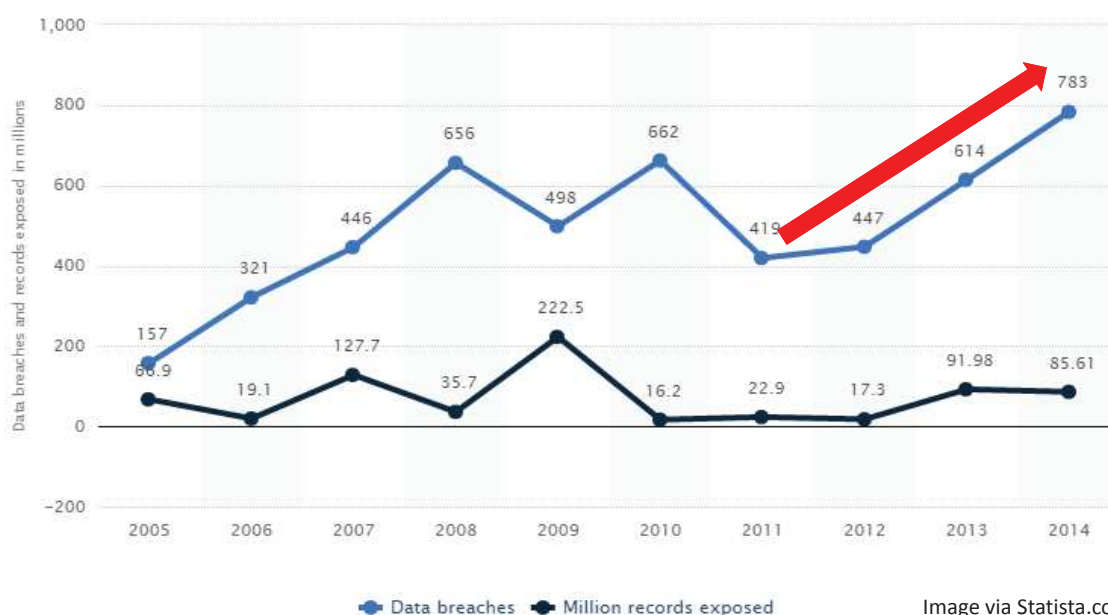
