- Oil and Gas Operators
- In-the-Field Activities
- Upstream and Midstream

RRC Jurisdiction Includes:

- Oil and Gas Wells
 - Drilling, Completion, Production, and Abandonment
- Protection of Water Resources from Oil and Gas Operations
- Oil and Gas Waste Disposal and Clean Up



RRC Jurisdiction Includes:

- Disposal Injection of Salt Water and Oil and Gas Waste,
- Injection for Secondary or Enhanced Recovery
- Injection for Storage of Gas or Liquid Hydrocarbons

RRC Jurisdiction Includes:

- Gathering Line and Pipeline Design,
 Installation, Maintenance, and Operation
- Transportation and Takes by Texas Gas
 Utilities, Common Carriers, and Common Purchasers.
