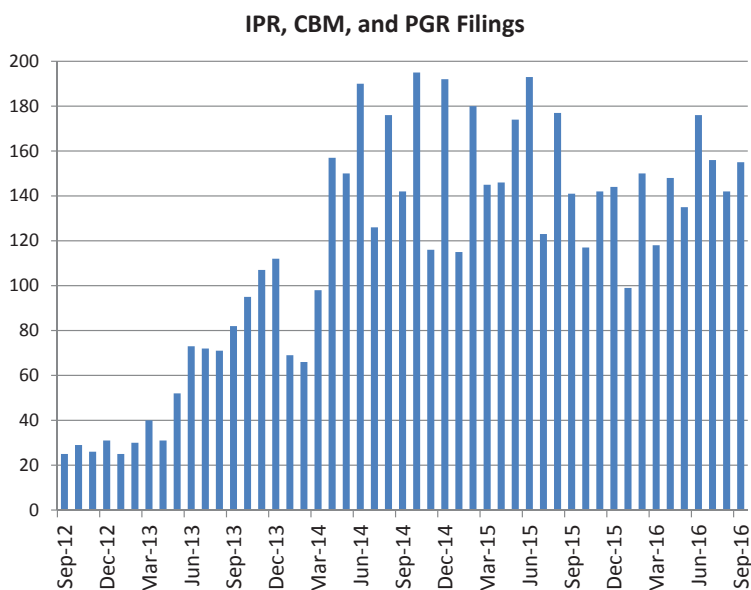

Overview of PTAB Activity

(All stats through September 2016)

- Since September 16, 2012, **5,155** IPR petitions, **476** CBM petitions, and **37** PGR petitions have been filed.
- Averaged **150** petitions per month in 2015 – slightly up over 2014. Filings are down to around **140** per month in 2016.

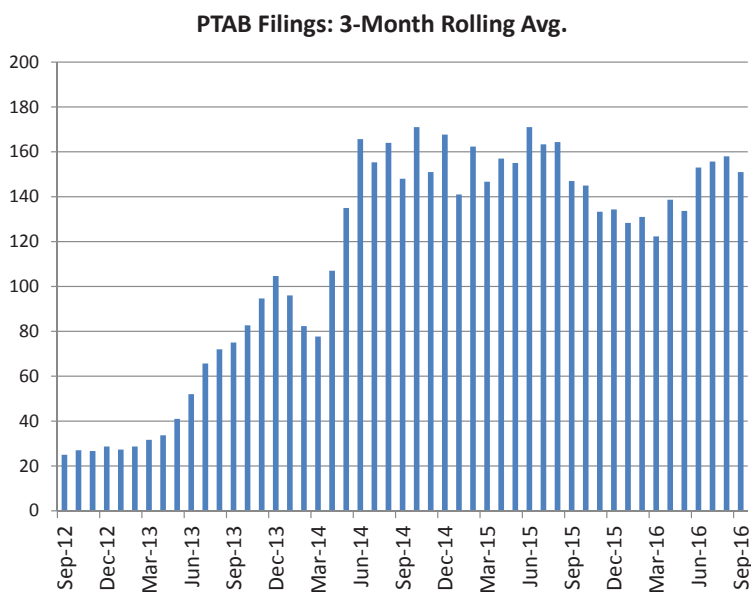

Overview of PTAB Activity

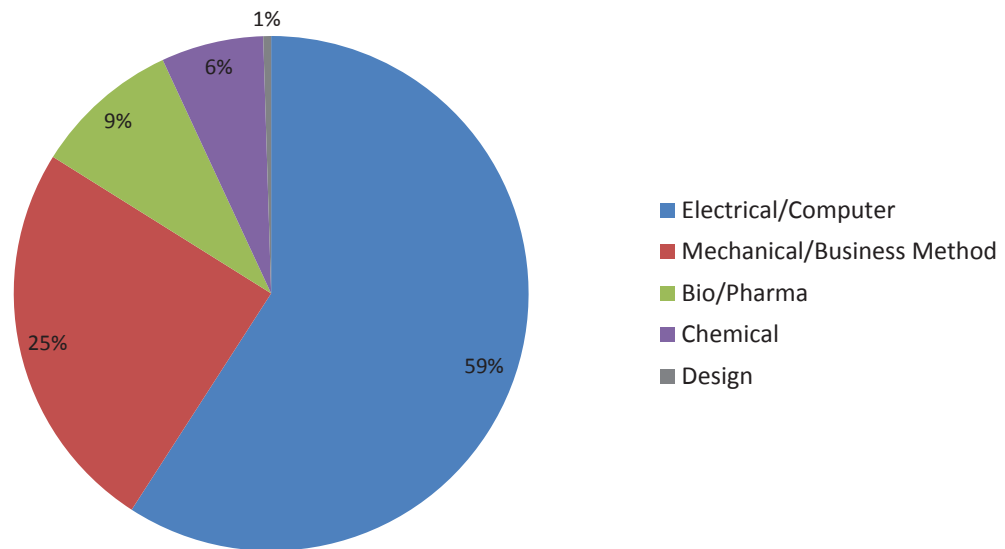
(All stats through September 2016)

- It took nearly 18 months for the first 1,000 petitions to be filed.
- Each subsequent 7–8 month period has seen around 1,000 petitions filed.



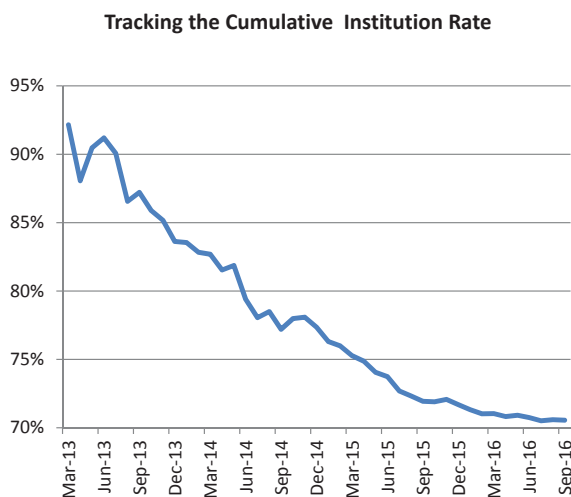

PTAB Institution Outcomes



Period	Institution Rate
FY2013	86.8%
First Half FY2014	78.5%
Second Half FY2014	71.2%
1 st Quarter FY2015	77.7%
2 nd Quarter FY2015	68.8%
3 rd Quarter FY2015	63.6%
4 th Quarter FY2015	62.5%
1 st Quarter FY2016	69.1%
2 nd Quarter FY2016	65.5%
3 rd Quarter FY2016	66.2%
4 th Quarter FY2016	68.1%
Total	70.6%

- In **IPRs**, trial has been instituted for **71%** of proceedings and **62%** of the challenged claims.
- In **CBMs**, trial has been instituted for **68%** of proceedings and **63%** of the challenged claims.
