

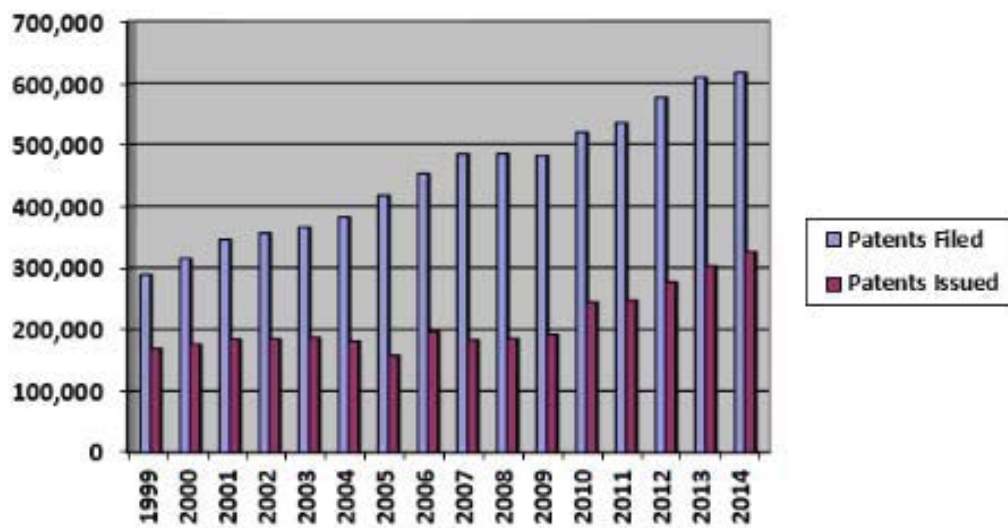

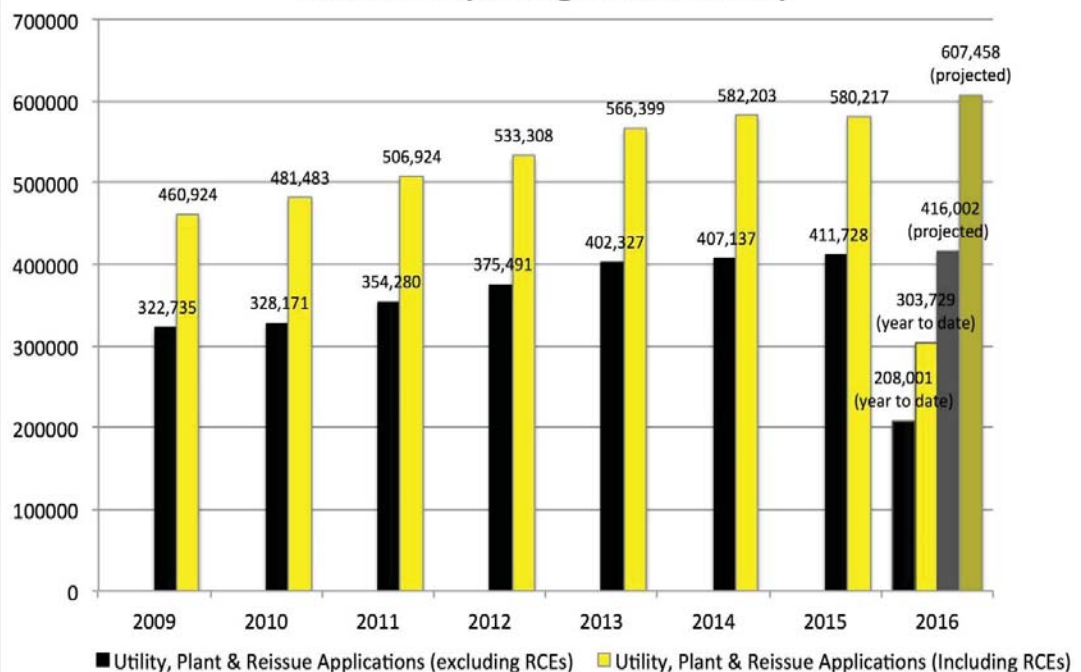
## The Patent ~~Crisis~~ Crises

**Calendar Years 1999 - 2014**



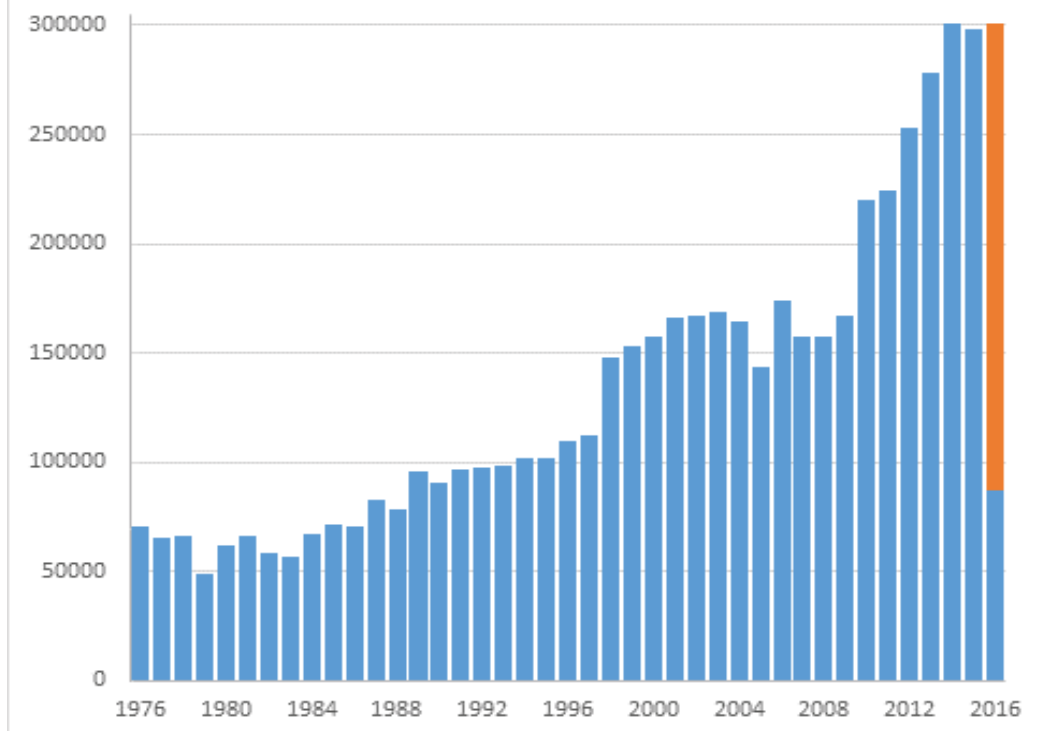
**Utility, Plant and Reissue Patent Applications Filed per  
Fiscal Year (through March 2016)**



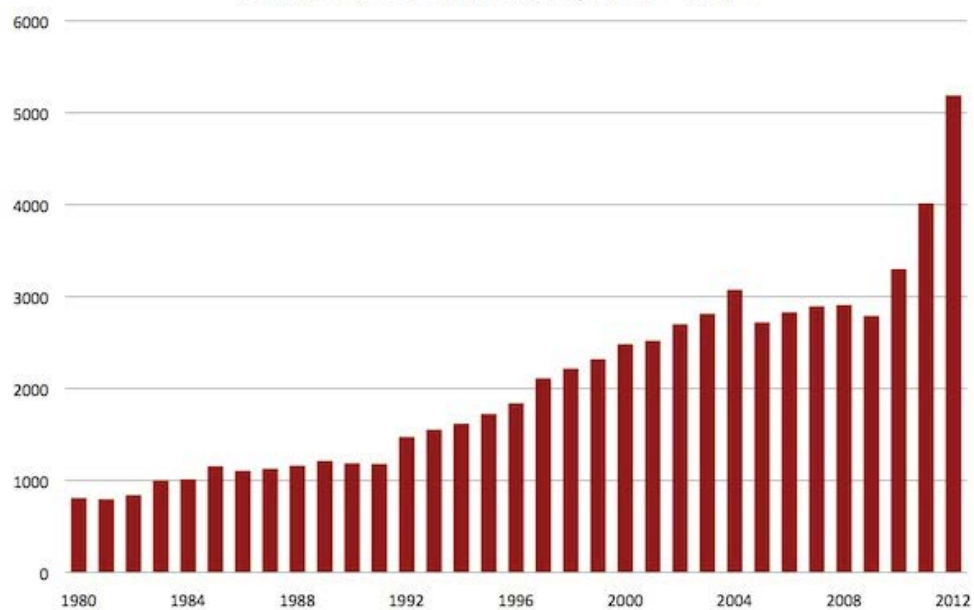
