HIPAA and Patient Data

- Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act of 1996 (45 C.F.R. parts 160 & 164) provides a framework for establishment of nationwide protection of patient confidentiality, security of electronic systems, and standards and requirements for electronic transmission of health information.
- Penalties vary but a violation can be a minimum of \$100 to \$50,000 per incident.
- Civil penalties up to \$1,500,000/year for identical types of violations.
- Criminal penalties for knowingly obtaining and wrongfully sharing information.
- A data breach or security incident that results from any HIPAA violation could see separate fines issued for different aspects of the single breach under various security and privacy standards.
