I. Electric Power Developments

A. 2017 Legislative Session

- Siting of Wind Farms (SB 277)
- Rate Cases for ERCOT Electric Utilities (SB 735)

B. Regulatory Enactments

- Legislative Implementations
 - PUC new rule 16 TAC §25.246 implements a portion of HB 1535 from the 84th Legislature.
 - PUC amended 16 TAC §§ 25.101, 25.174, and 25.192 implement mandates from SB 776, SB 933, and HB 1535 of the 84th Legislature.
- The PUC amended §25.181 to require electric utilities residential and commercial energy efficiency cost recovery factor (EECRF) cost caps be increased or decreased by a rate equal to the most recently available calendar year's percentage change in the South urban consumer price index (CPI) determined by the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics.

B. Regulatory Enactments (Cont'd.)

- The PUC amended §25.507, relating to ERCOT's Emergency Response Service (ERS). The amendment allows ERS resources to participate in Must-Run-Alternative arrangements to replace the need for Reliability Must-Run generation resources.
- The PUC amended §25.211 to modify the Agreement for Interconnection and Parallel Operation of Distributed Generation (Interconnection Agreement).
- The PUC amended §25.474 for the limited purpose of allowing a Retail Electric Provider (REP) or aggregator to use a portable electronic device during customer enrollments via door-to-door sales.
