## ABSENCE OF CERTAIN PREVIOUSLY PROPOSED CHANGES

- ➤ Option to expense intangible drilling costs.
- ➤ Percentage depletion.
- ➤ Geological and geophysical costs.
- ➤ Deduction for tertiary injectants.
- > Exception to passive loss limitations for certain working interests.
- ►LIFO.
