## **Setting Depositions**

- 1. Who do you want to depose?
- 2. Send a deposition request letter.
- 3. Send a second deposition request letter.
- 4. Send a third deposition request letter.
- 5. Issue a notice.

## Get the Notice and Duces Tecum Correct

- Is this individual or corporate capacity?
- Be specific in the *duces tecum*.
- Timely serve the *duces tecum*.
- For organization representatives, narrowly and specifically identify areas to be covered.
- Can you compel attendance?
- State in notice that deposition may be videotaped.
