GRANTMAKING BASICS

COMMON TYPES OF GRANTMAKERS

- Public Charities
- Community Foundations
- Donor-Advised Funds
- Corporations
- Government Grants
- Private Foundations

PRIVATE FOUNDATION GRANTMAKING

- Annually required to distribute a minimum of 5% of the previous year's net average fair market value of assets
- Pays 1% to 2% excise tax on capital gains
- Prohibited from directly lobbying or participating in political campaigns

COMMON TYPES OF GRANTS

- Unrestricted: General Operating
- Restricted: Programmatic, Capital, Endowment, Other Requirements
- Program-Related Investments
