Healthcare Reform – HR 3590 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)

- Repeal Dead vs Piecemeal Repeal
 - Individual Mandate
 - Enrollment
 - o Percentage of adults without insurance

2016 - 10.9% 2017 - 12.4% 2018 - 13.7%

 Value-based programs reward health care providers with incentive payments for the quality of care they give to people with Medicare
