Actual and Projected Net Medicare Spending, 2010-2028

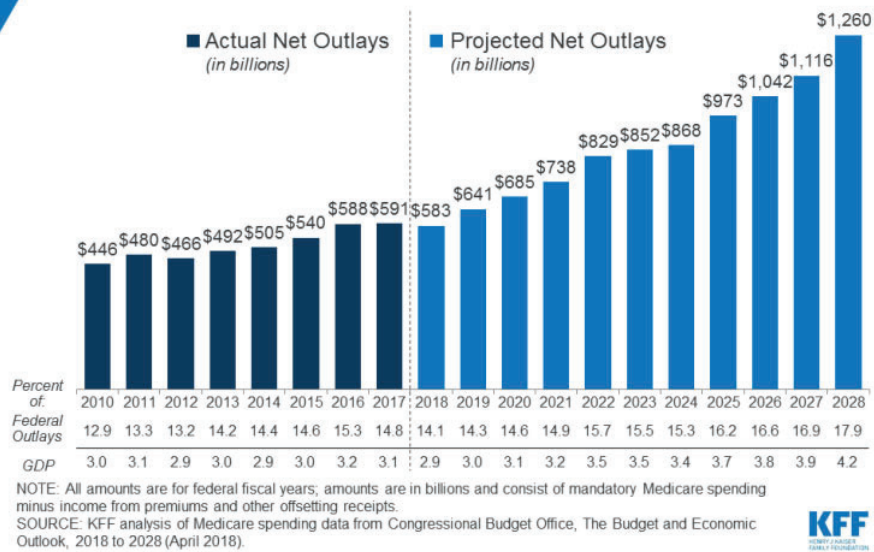
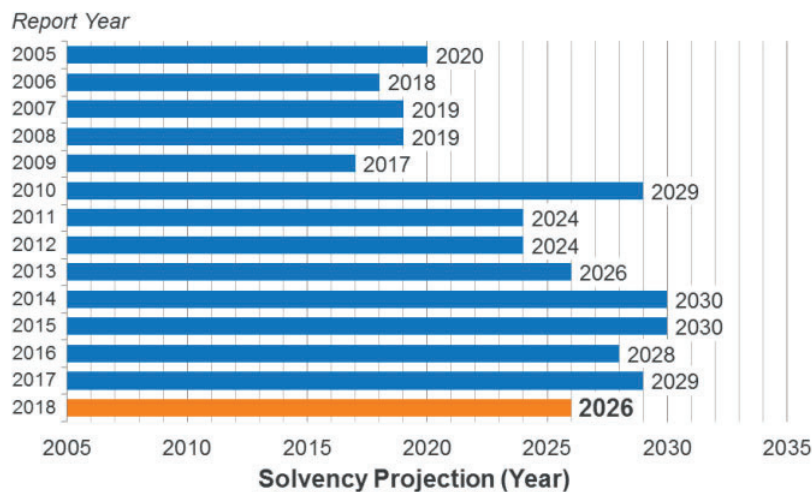
