CSA FRAMEWORK

The Controlled Substances Act established a "closed system" that tracks and accounts for controlled substances that are acquired and distributed from the import or manufacture level through distribution to the ultimate end-user

Schedules of Controlled Substances Under the CSA

- · Schedule I-- no currently accepted medical use
 - -- e.g., he m in, LSD, marijua na
- Schedule II -- accepted medical use, but high potential for abuse and abuse may lead to severe psychological or physical dependence
 - -- <u>e.g.</u>, o xyc o d o ne, hyd ro c o d o ne, fe nta nyl, me tha d o ne
