### In-Hospital/Health care facility DNRs

- DNR orders in ED
  - Out-of-Hospital DNR form
  - In-Hospital DNR order
  - Door #3
- Attending Physician can there be more than one?
- Revocation of In-Hospital DNR
  - Patient
  - Legal guardian or MPOA agent

## In-Hospital/ Health care facility DNRs

- Provider Patient dispute over order
  - Subchapter E provides for notice and reasonable attempt to transfer patient to another provider
  - No reference to use of hospital ethics committee
- Amending medical staff bylaws
  - How much detail is required
  - Cross-referencing medical staff/hospital policies

### 2018 NPDB Guidebook Revisions

- Length of restriction actual length controls
- Voluntary agreement while under investigation is reportable
- LOA while under investigation is reportable
- Reappointment inquiry that deviates from routine may be seen as investigation
- Resignation while under QIP/PIP may be reportable (as may be QIP/PIP)

### 2018 NPDB Guidebook Revisions

- Requiring first assistant is considered a reportable restriction
- Expiration of appointment term while under investigation is reportable
- Court order may mandate second report
