Background of the CCPA

(How We Got Here)

MAKING HISTORY

- California is the first U.S. state to enact *comprehensive* data protection legislation with passage of CCPA.
 - **Who:** California Residents
 - **What:** “GDPR-like” rights of access and control for individuals.
 - **When:** Effective January 1, 2020*
 - **How:** California Constitution’s “inalienable” right of privacy
 - **Why:** Response to Cambridge Analytica scandal

TIMEFRAME. IMPACT. ISSUES.

- **Timeframe:** California lawmakers unanimously passed CCPA in less than a week to avoid passage of a more stringent law.
- **Impact:** Imposes significant obligations and restrictions on businesses across the U.S. that handle the personal information of California residents.
- **Issues:** Includes drafting errors and ambiguities due to the speed with which the legislation made its way to the governor.

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
