Avenatti Complaint

- Client is a coach of an amateur athletic union men?s basketball program based in California. For a number of years, the AAU program coached by Clientl had a sponsorship agreement with Nike pursuant to which Nike paid the AAU program approximately \$72,000 annually.
- "AVENATTI further stated...that he would refrain from holding that press conference and damaging Nike if Nike agreed to two demands: (1) Nike must pay \$1.5 million to Clientl as a settlement for any claims Clientl might have regarding Nike's decision not to renew its contract with the team coached by Clientl; and (2) Nike must hire AVENATTI and to conduct an internal investigation of Nike, [and pay at least \$25 million]
