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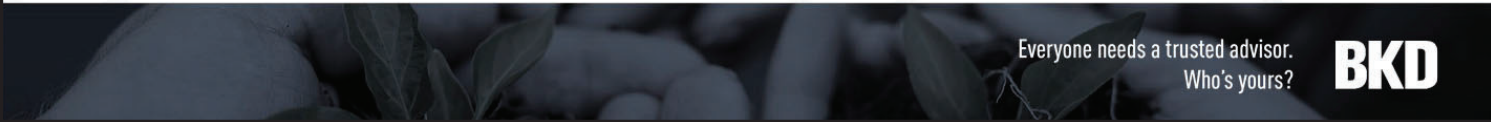

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Management Considerations on Metrics & Analytics

- Allows management to better
 - Understand what has happened
 - Have a better budgeting process
 - Evaluate what needs to happen
 - Trend analysis to look for abnormal results & make expectations
 - Forecasting to evaluate cash flows
 - Make key decisions in staffing, funding, expenses, revenues, cash, etc.
 - Mission-related decisions on various programs effectiveness

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Board Considerations on Metrics & Analytics

- Allows the board to better

 - Identify potential weaknesses & strengths
 - Trend analysis to look for abnormal results & make expectations
