# Freelance includes all of these other terms:

- Temporary lawyer
- Contract lawyer
- Freelance lawyer

Contract often implies attachment to a single firm while freelance means doing work for many different firms.



# Who is the "hiring" lawyer?



### The term hiring lawyer may also be synonymous with:

- Retaining lawyer
- Engaging lawyer
- Outsourcing lawyer

Many ethics opinions use them interchangeably

# Types of freelance legal services



One lawyer hires a non-employee lawyer to provide legal services to the firm for a client

Usually done with independent contractor agreements identifying the services

Defined fees or flat rates and limits of services
