Preparation



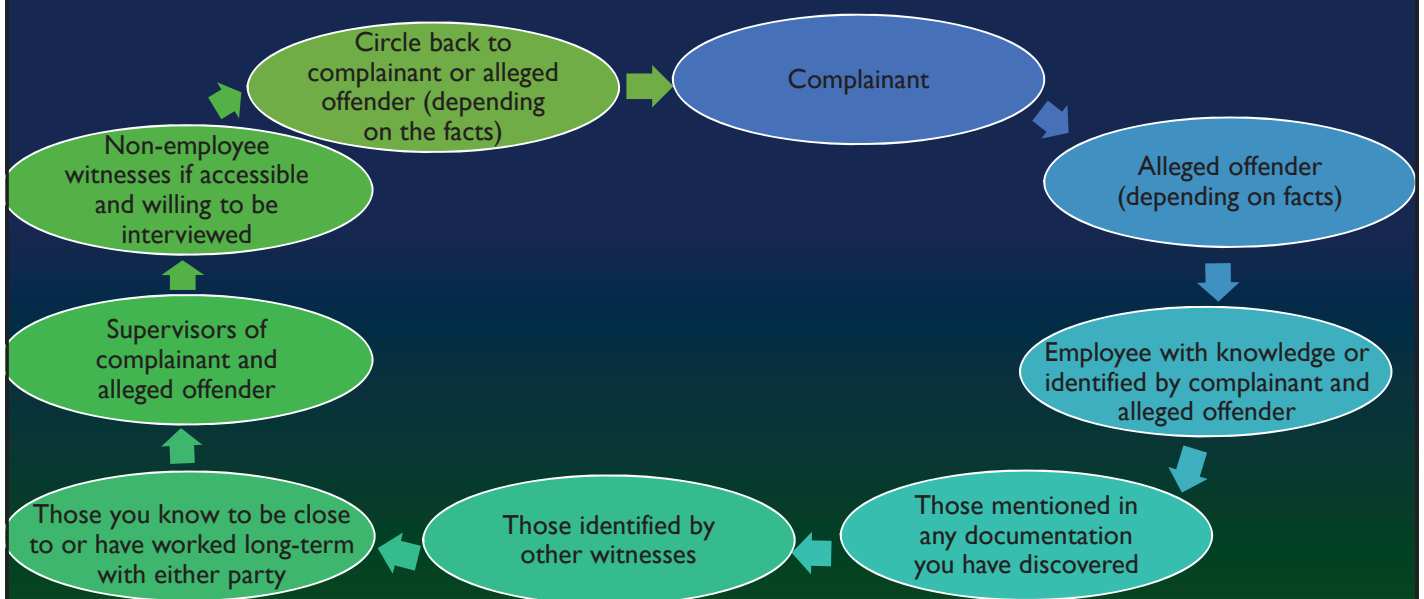
Preparation

- Assess the complaint and determine scope
- Determine if immediate or interim measures are required
- Determine who will investigate

Preparation

- Prepare an investigation plan
 - Identify witnesses
 - Determine likely order of witnesses
 - Identify documents/policies to collect/review
- Create a timeline and estimated deadline for investigation
- Determine location of interviews
- Develop opening script/questions
