


 Determines charges based on grounds of inadmissibility & deportability

#### Notice to Appear

- ► Issued by DHS
- Filed with Immigration Judge
- Hearings before Immigration Judge (IJ)
  - Bond re-determination
  - Master calendar
  - Hearing on the merits

### Other Forms of Removal

- ▶ Waivers of hearing and voluntary return
- Expedited removal
- Stipulated removal
- Re-instatement of removal order
