Recovery Rebates

- Starting in April 2020, the federal government issued recovery rebates to qualified individuals under the CARES Act.
 - \$1,200 per individual or
 - \$2,400 per married couple filing jointly
 - with an additional \$500 paid for each qualifying child under the age of 17.
 - The recovery rebates were paid to
 - individuals earning less than \$75,000,
 - \$150,000 per married couple filing jointly, or
 - \$112,500 for heads of household, and
 - decreased by 5% of income exceeding those thresholds until completely phased out.
