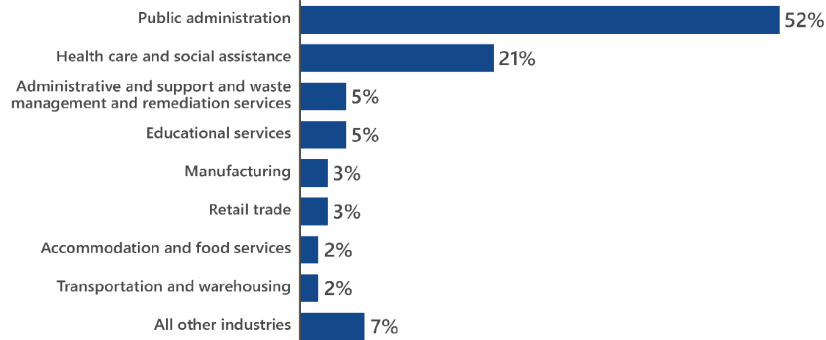

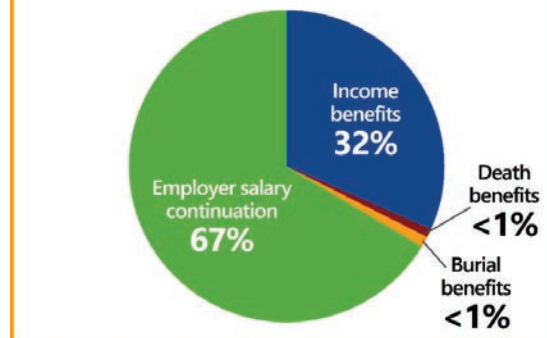
### Distribution of COVID-19 Claims by Industry
