What are FF and CL?

Findings of fact:

- Take the place of a jury verdict
- Provide the factual framework for the judgment

Conclusions of law:

Legal basis for the judgment

What are the purposes of FF?

- Narrow issues for appeal
- Provide basis to attack judgment
- Critical for preserving certain errors
- Pretrial and trial tool

_

How are FF unique from other post-judgment motions?

- Shorter deadline
- Preservation requires filing multiple docs
- Preservation obligation falls on both parties
