

Name Reservations

Practice Tips:

- Include the intended organizational identifier in the name to be reserved
 - Difference between acceptance with consent or rejection as the same
 [1 TAC §79.40]
- Avoid rejection of subsequent submission! Rather than naming the firm or individual attorney as the applicant of the name reservation, identify the client who will be an initial governing person.

Registered Agent Name Issues

 Be clear when identifying the person designated as the initial registered agent of the entity or when completing organizer information.

The following creates issues:

"The initial registered agent is: ABC Inc., Attn: John Doe"
