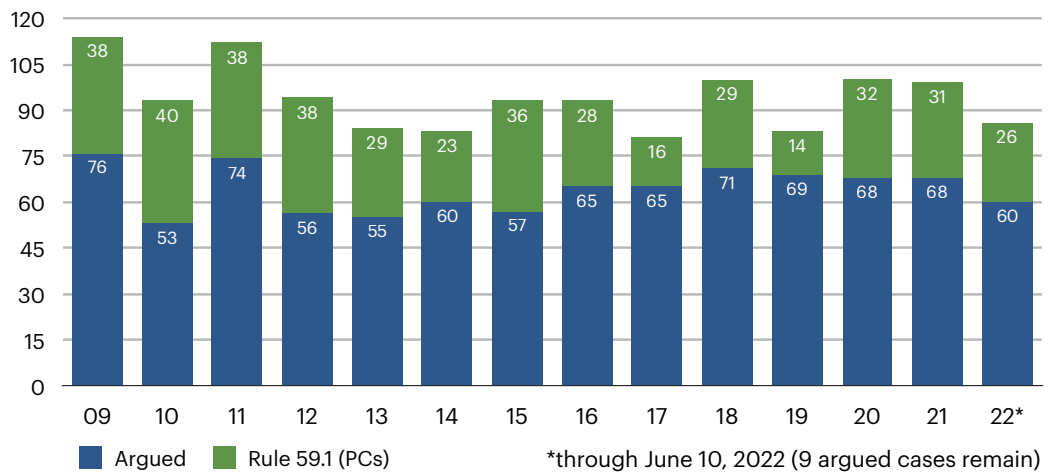

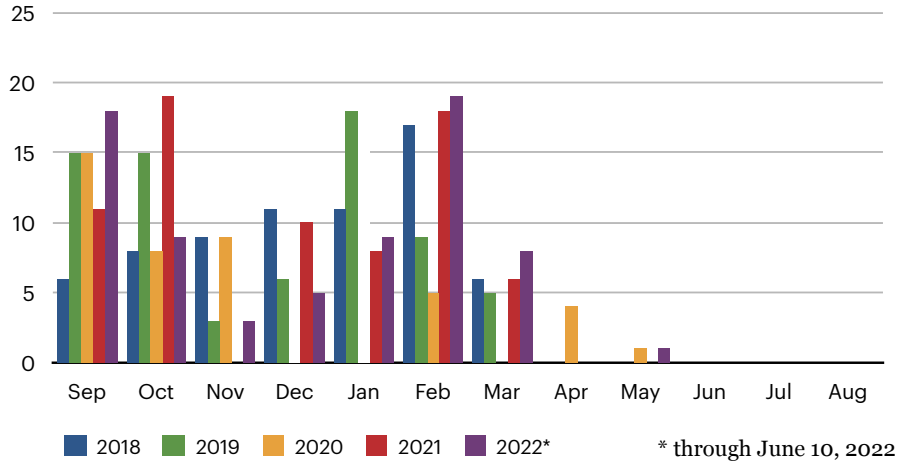

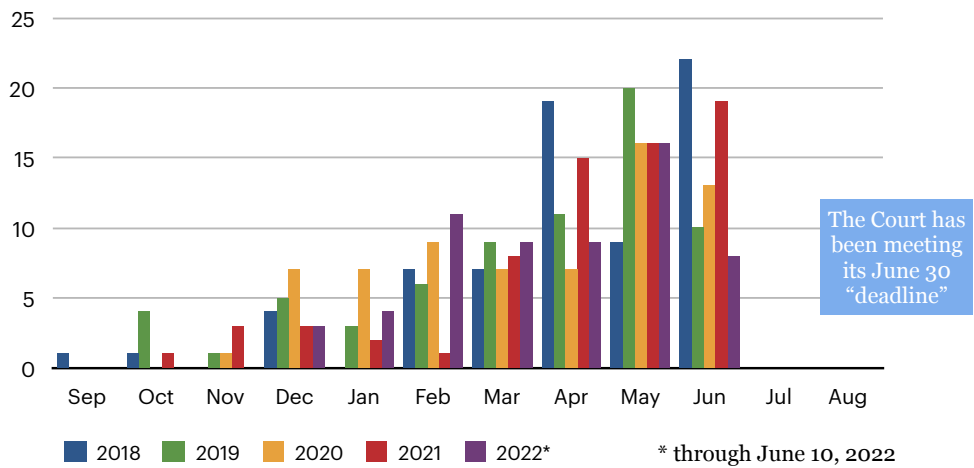
# When are oral arguments?
