### Pre-Formation Issues—Entity Names

SOS determines the availability of legal and fictitious names of corporations, limited liability companies, including registered series of a domestic limited liability company, limited partnerships, cooperative associations, and professional associations, as well as the availability of entity name reservations and name registrations.

#### Names Not Considered

The following are not considered when making an entity name availability determination:

- Assumed Names (state or local)
- LLP Names
- State or Federal Trademark Registrations
- Common Law Use





## Entity Name Availability Standard §§ 5.053, 5.102 & 5.153 BOC

- Distinguishable in the Records
  - -name is available
- Same
  - -name is not available, even with consent
- Available with Consent
  - name is not distinguishable but is permitted with notarized consent

#### Names that are the Same

1 TAC §79.39

Certain conditions define when a proposed entity name is considered to be the same as an existing name. Names are the same if the only difference between names is:

- Use of upper case or lower case letters, distinctive lettering or typeface, use of superscript or subscript letters or numerals.
- Use of punctuation, accent marks, spaces, or other spacing symbols.
- Use of different articles or conjunctions.
- Repetition, absence of or differences in letters.
