Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f) Conference of the Parties, Planning for Discovery

### <u>TIMING</u>

• "as soon as practicable" - must occur twenty-one (21) days before a scheduling conference or scheduling order is due under Rule 16(b). Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f)(1)

### **CONFERENCE CONTENT**

- Considering claims, defenses, and possibilities of settlement/resolution of case,
- Discuss discovery preservation, and
- Develop a discovery plan. Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f)(2)

### Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f) Conference of the Parties, Planning f<u>or Discovery</u>

### **RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES**

- Arranging the conference,
- Good faith attempt to agree on discovery plan, and
- Submission of discovery plan fourteen (14) days after the conference. Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f)(2).

### Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f) Conference of the Parties, Planning for Discovery

#### DISCOVERY PLAN REQUIREMENTS: Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(f)(3)

- (A) Changes as to timing, form, or requirement of initial disclosures required under Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 26(a)
- (B) Discovery subjects, timing, and method (in phases or by issue)
- (C) Electronically stored information details
- (D) Privilege or of protection as trial-preparation materials
- (E) Limitations of discovery
- (F) Orders issued by Court under Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 16(b)(c), 26(c)
