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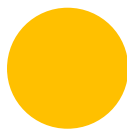
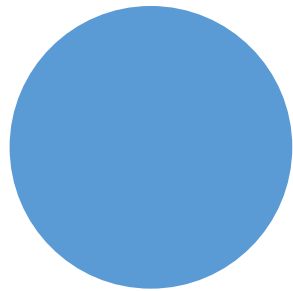
Risk Assessment and Information Security



- What are the organization's key goals and mission?
- What are the key cyber risks that could affect the organization's ability to achieve its business objectives? What kind of information does the organization have?
- How does the organization assess the impact of cyber risk on organizational objectives?
- How are key cyber risks managed?
 - Acceptance
 - Avoidance
 - Mitigation
 - Transfer
- Each organization has a different risk profile that changes over time
 - Every organization (and the individuals within it) have different risk tolerances and appetite for risk which can affect incident response approaches and coverage desired

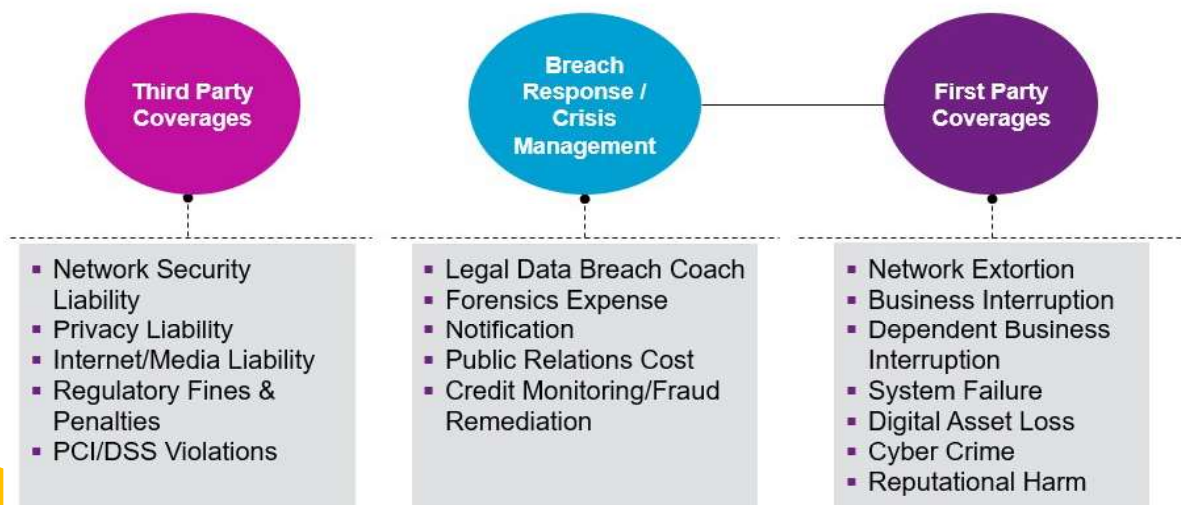
- Cyber/Privacy Liability addresses the first- and third-party risks associated with e-business, the Internet, networks, intellectual property, and informational assets against privacy breaches.
