



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINTS

- 37 CFR § 11.32 Predicated on "probable cause" by COD
- 37 CFR § 11.24 Reciprocal discipline
- 37 CFR § 11.25 Interim suspension based on serious criminal conviction

TIMING FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- 35 USC § 32 Proceedings commenced not later than earlier of:
 - o 10 years after misconduct occurred; or
 - ol year from date conduct was made known to the USPTO
