CHAIKIN: We're also seeking, on a final basis, authorization to serve that notice on the creditor matrix as well as authorization to redact personal identifying information, specifically individuals' home addresses and in some cases, their names as well, and redact that information from publicly filed versions of the creditor matrix, the schedules and statements, and other documents such as affidavits of service and fee applications.

As set forth in Paragraph 1 of the proposed order, 23 \parallel the debtors are proposing to the Court, the United States Trustee, and counsel to the committee, once it's appointed, will automatically receive unredacted versions of any of those
