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Healthcare Reform Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)

- Increase in enrollment
 - 50% increase since Biden took office
- 16.3 million enrollees, 3.6 million new
- 92% have the option of 3 or more plans

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Value-Based Programs

 Value-based programs reward health care providers with incentive payments for the quality of care they give to people with Medicare

(CMS.gov)

- Growth of Medicare Advantage (Part D)
- Safe, appropriate and effective care with enduring results and reasonable costs (Dartmouth-Hitchcock)
- Not Fee For Service
 - MSSP Medicare Shared Savings Program
 - ACO REACH
 - Bundles
