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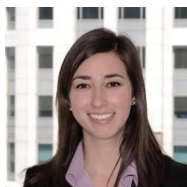

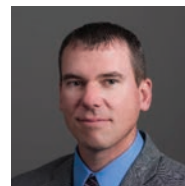

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Section 512(a)(6): Buckets and Silos



- Final regulations effective 12/2/2020 (for the tax year that begins on or after)
- Commonly referred to as “silo-ing” or “basketing”
- 2 digit NAICS codes used to group activities
- Active trade or business vs. pass-through activities
