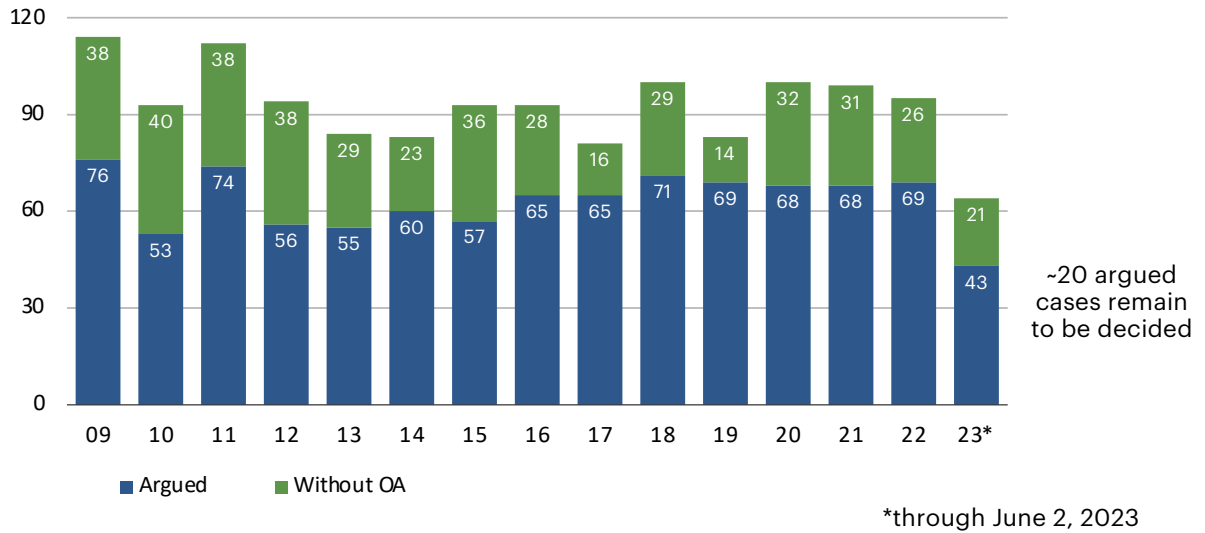

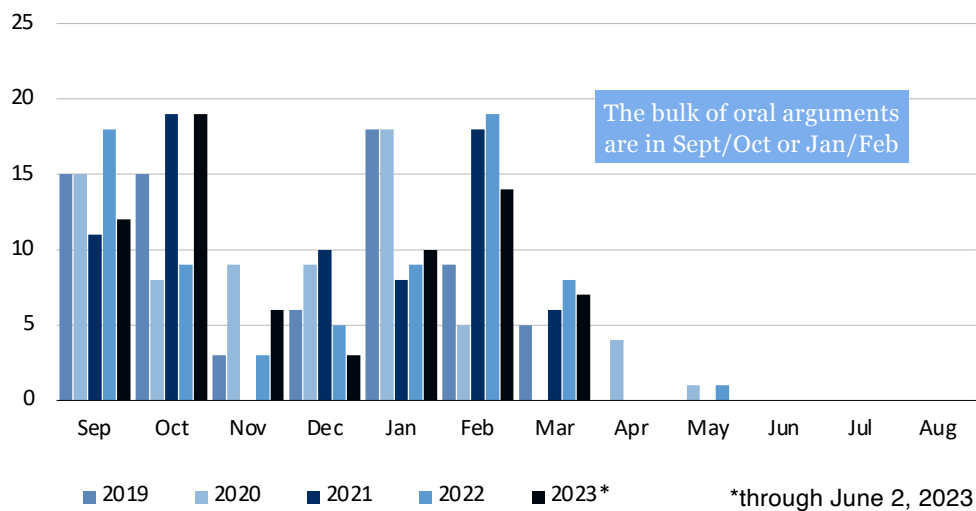
Opinion Output

When are oral arguments?

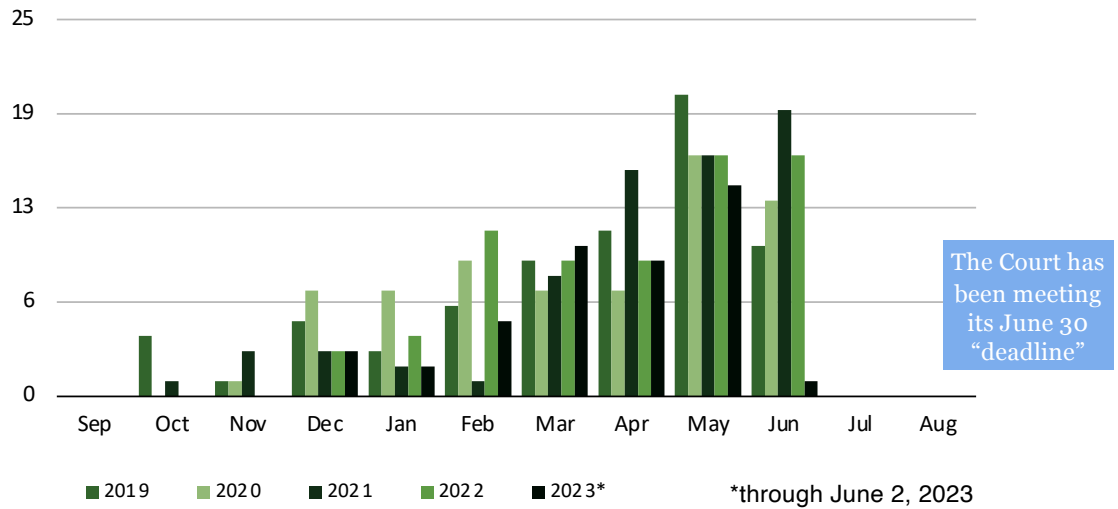
This has been the pattern since I've been tracking.

When are opinions issued?

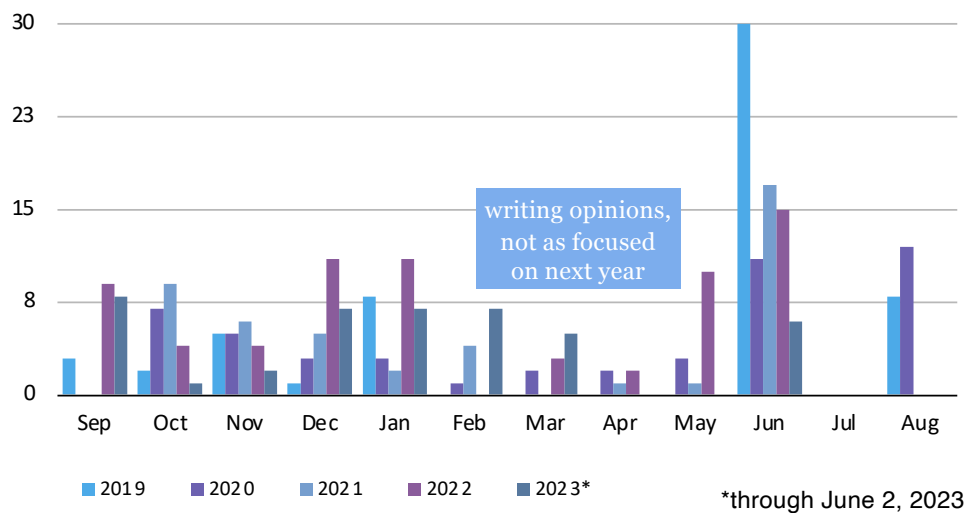
Excluding Rule 59.1 cases and “corrected” opinions
