#### What we do:

- Review current purpose gift agreements of \$100,000 and higher
- Oversee and facilitate the naming process
  - 50-70 proposals a year
- Oversee and facilitate the endowment creation process
  - Around 300 new and 50 amended endowments annually
- Perform compliance on endowments
  - 8,570+ endowments review 20% annually and other activities
- Deliver annual endowment principal account financial statements
  - 8,000 statements to 5,100 households (email or regular mail)
- Prepare specialized endowment reports, as required
