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



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What Is a Trademark



- Any Word, Name, Symbol or Device Used to <u>Identify</u> <u>Source</u> of a good or service
- Unlimited term if use continues
- Takes 1 2 years to get federal registration
 - National in scope
 - \$2,000+

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Who Owns a Trademark

- In U.S. 1st Party to <u>Use</u> the Mark "in commerce"
 - Not the first to incorporate, file an assumed name, register a domain name, or even a trademark registration
 - But you can back date your rights by filing an "intent to use" federal trademark application
 - Internationally 1st to <u>Register</u> is typical
- In Connection with the <u>Sale</u> of Goods or the <u>Rendering</u> of Services
- In a <u>Geographic</u>Area
