Why, What, Who & Where Title Standards?

<u>Why:</u> To alleviate disagreements among title examiners by setting forth standards on which title examiners can generally agree to promote uniformity.

<u>What:</u> Statements that declare an answer to a question or a solution to a problem, commonly encountered in title examination.
