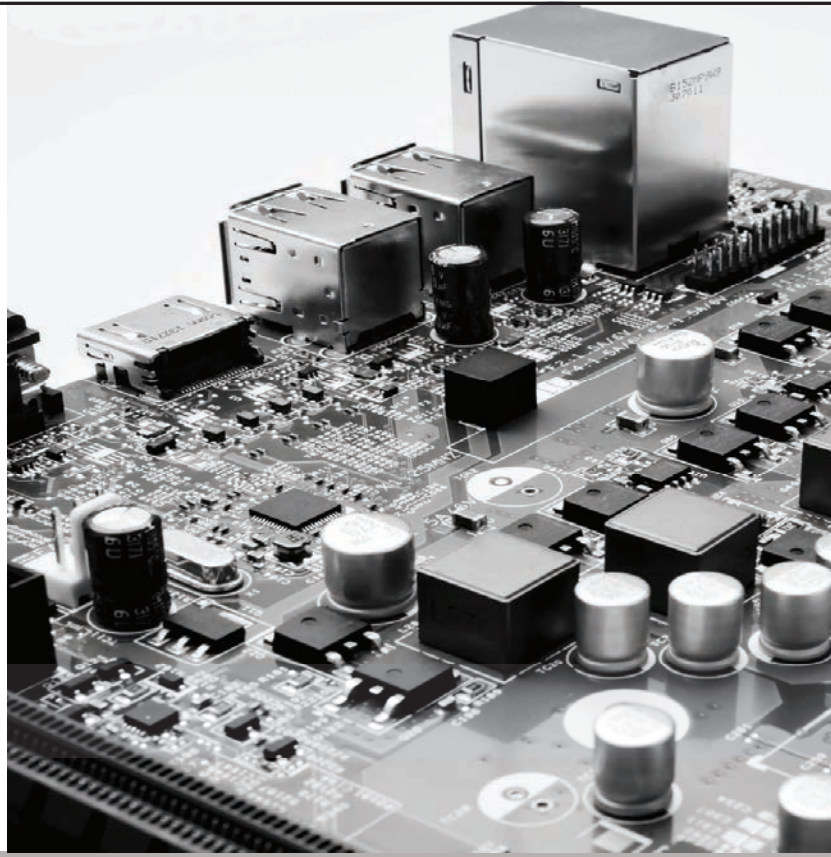
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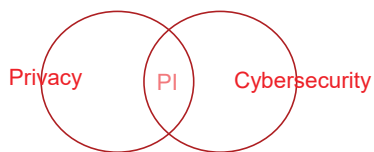

- Expansive definition covers any information that *directly or indirectly* identifies an individual.

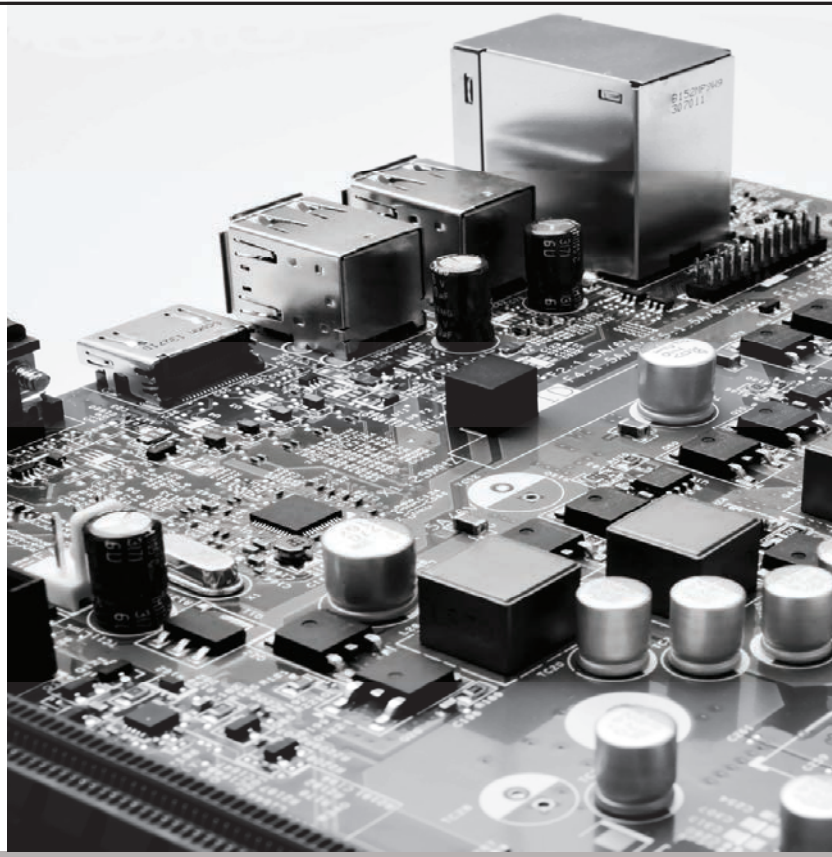

Canada: Personal Information Protection and electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA)	UK: Data Protection Act of 2018 & UK GDPR; Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR)	New Zealand: Bill of Rights Act (1990), Human Rights Act (1993), and the Privacy Act (1993) (amended 2020)
Mexico: Federal Laws on Protection of Personal Data Held by Private Parties (2010)	Argentina: Personal Data Protection Law (PDPL), Decree 1558 of 2001	Republic of Korea: Personal Information Protection Act (2011) (amended 2020)
Brazil: Lei Geral de Proteção de Dados Pessoais (LGPD)	Australia: Privacy Act (1988) (amended 2014) (under review by Attorney General), Notifiable Data Breaches scheme 2018	India: Draft of Personal Data Protection Bill (2019) (awaiting reintroduction before Indian Parliamentary Committee)

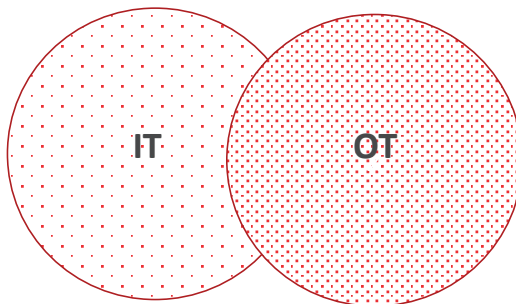
